DEADLINE FOR ENTRY: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2017

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Competition is open to all middle and high school students.

Theme: Art or Innovation

Only two-dimensional artwork will be accepted in the following categories:

- Paintings: oil, watercolor, acrylic, tempera
- Drawings: colored pencil, pencil, ink, markers, pastels, charcoal (please fix pastels and charcoal)
- Collage: must be two-dimensional
- Mixed Media: use of more than two mediums, such as ink, pencil, watercolor, etc.
- Prints: lithographs, silkscreen, block prints
- Photography
- Computer-generated art
- Artwork must be produced on paper stock appropriate for the medium used.
- Paper size: either 12"x18" or 18"x24"
- Artwork must be matted. Mat no larger than 3" all the way around the artwork. NO FRAMES.
- Please print on the back of artwork in the upper right-hand corner: Student-Artist's full name, Teacher's name, and School.
- One entry allowed per person.
- Each entry must be original in concept, design, and execution. No trademarks, tracing of others' artwork, copyrighted photographs, copying from an existing photograph, or scanned reproductions of a painting or drawing.

SUITABILITY GUIDELINES

All artwork must be suitable for a family environment. Any artwork deemed offensive, depicting subjects of contemporary political controversy, or of a sensationalistic or gruesome nature will not be displayed.

EXHIBITING, JUDGING AND ANNOUNCING

- All suitable artwork will be displayed from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at City Council Chambers (3900 Main St.) , on the evening of October 12, 2017.
- The top 24 winning artworks will be determined by public vote. An individual must be present to vote. The Student-Artist need not be present to win.
- A panel of judges will select ONE artwork for "Best of Show."
- The one Student-Artist whose artwork receives "Best of Show" will be awarded an iPad Mini (16 GB). Their teacher will also receive an iPad Mini (16 GB).
- Voters who pick the winning artworks will be entered into a raffle to win one of two \$50.00 gift cards from Amazon.com or one art class from the Riverside Art Museum.
- Winning Student-Artists and their Teachers' names will be posted on the City's Long Night of Arts & Innovation website, www.LongNightRiverside.com, on October 20, 2017.

- Winning artwork will be displayed at the Riverside Art Museum in the Taylor Family Gallery beginning October 18 through November 14, 2017.
- Mayor Bailey will hold a special reception acknowledging the winning Student-Artists and their Teachers on November 1, 2017. The reception will be from 5:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

STUDENT INFORMATION AND RELEASE FORM

Each entrant must submit a *Student Information* and *Release Form*. The form requires:

- Student-Artist's name, phone number, grade, and title of artwork
- Teacher's name, email, School's name, address, and Phone Number
- A signed Release Form certifies that the artwork is original in design and execution and contains a legal release for the Long Night of Arts & Innovation and the Riverside Art Museum. The student and a parent or guardian, if the student is a minor, must sign the Release Form. This Form **must be** securely attached to the back of the artwork.

REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENTS, PARENTS/GUARDIANS AND TEACHERS

- Matted artwork no larger than 24"x30"
- Artwork meets suitability and originality guidelines.
- Signed *Student Information* and *Release Form* attached to the back of the artwork.

TEACHER INFORMATION AND CLASS FORM

- Please complete one *Teacher Information* and *Class Form* per class.
- Place all class entries into one package.
- Please securely attach the *Teacher Information* and *Class Form* to the outside of the package.
- **All entries must be received at City Hall, 3900 Main Street, Riverside, CA 92522 – Mayor's Office, 7th Floor, no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 6, 2015.** For your convenience, we will have a person (located at Ninth and Main Streets) in front of City Hall from 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 6 to collect your class's artwork packet. We will also accept individual student artwork.

AFTER THE EVENT

Art packets will be ready for pick up after November 3, 2017 at City Hall – Mayor's Office, 7th Floor. Packages must be picked up by November 24, 2017 or the artwork becomes the property of the Long Night of Arts & Innovation.
